Children who attend the Oasis crèche can be particularly vulnerable and you will be responsible for ensuring safeguarding procedures are prioritised and followed at all times, You will be a confident communicator and enjoy working in a team.

- Minimum of Level 2 childcare qualification or degree in Early Years
- At least 1 year relevant significant experience of working with children and families in an early years setting
- Demonstrable experience of safeguarding children legislation and processes
- Experience of implementing a varied range of activities with children and generating new activities and creative ideas.

# **Early Years Supervisor: What you will do:**

You will be a positive, self-reliant and innovative manager who can role model outstanding practice in an Early Years setting. You will have the ability to pick up on a handover of work demands quickly and will be confident in responding to child safeguarding concerns, ensuring safeguarding procedures are followed and concerns escalated concerns effectively. You will be able to demonstrate accurate record keeping and the passing on of appropriate information, understanding what may be able to wait for the regular supervisor and what needs a more urgent response. You will be confident at communicating with professionals and families alike. You will ensure the crèche provides a welcoming, happy and safe environment where every child is making good progress from their individual starting point. You will be a strong, encouraging communicator, able to lead effective discussions with the team. You will be experienced in line managing staff and volunteers.

### You will have:

- Level 3 childcare qualification or degree in Early Years
- At least 2 years relevant significant experience of working with children and families in an early years setting and be motivated for a new challenge
- Demonstrable experience of safeguarding children legislation and processes
- A resilient attitude and work in a way that is reflective, adaptable, and non-judgemental and adhere to professional boundaries at all times
- An understanding of current issues related to substance misuse and families experiencing problems will be desirable.
- Experience in formulating, operating, and evaluating a stimulating programme of activities for children
